for those who died on September 11, 2001.**



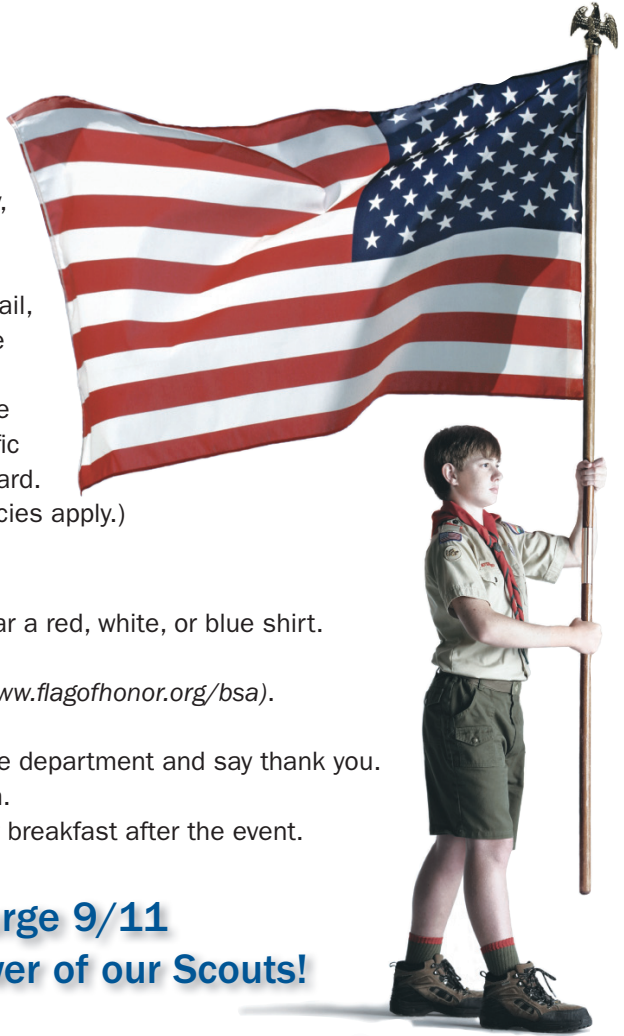
