Are your Webelos ready for Boy Scouts?

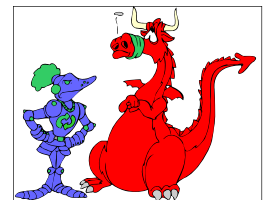
Webelos Resident Camp is 4 days and 3 nights of activities and fun to help your
