**Team Player Fee** LHAC Units that support the mission of the Lake Huron Area Council by participating in our annual Popcorn Sale and Friends of Scouting will receive the Team Player Fee until May 11, 2012. For qualifying units, the Team Player Fee discount will be credited back to your unit upon your arrival at camp - all units will pay the Regular Fee when registering for camp.

To qualify as a "Team Player" unit, on or before May 11, 2012 your unit must: (1) Schedule an FOS presentation with your District FOS Team and have at least 70% participation by your unit's families & leaders. The FOS presentation must be conducted by your District FOS Team. (2) Your unit must participate in the LHAC Trails End Popcorn 2011 Fall or 2012 Spring Sale & achieve a \$100/Scout average in your unit.

**Camperships** The Lake Huron Area Council provides limited assistance on an individual basis to those Scouts who could not otherwise attend summer camp due to financial hardship. Campership forms are available at the Council Service Center beginning on March 1<sup>st</sup>. Completed Campership forms are due by April 15<sup>th</sup>. Scouts who apply for a campership are still responsible for half of the regular camp fee and must adhere to the Payment Schedule.

## Online Payment Schedule

### Step 1 - Register Your Unit

As soon as you are ready (beginning on September 19, 2011), a representative from your unit should make an online registration through the LHAC web site to register your unit. From the LHAC Home Page, click on the "Council Calendar" link and navigate your way to June/July 2012 and then click on the week of camp you wish to attend. Next, simply click on the orange "Register Online" button and follow the instructions. At the time of registration you will be asked for your contact information, an estimate of the number of campers that may attend, your campsite preference, and to provide your \$100 camp deposit (payable by credit card or electronic check). If you signed up for Summer Camp 2012 prior to September 19, this step will be completed for you. Please note that the unit registration total is \$350, with a minimum deposit of \$100 being due at the time of registration and the balance due by January 6, 2012 (see Step 2). You will be given the option to pay the entire \$350 upon initial registration if you so choose. This will get your unit signed up for the 2012 Camp Season!

Once your unit has registered, your unit's representative will receive e-mail communications about the registration process and other camp news. In-council units can access their Summer Camp 2012 registration by clicking on the

"Registrations" link found on your Unit's Home Page. Out-of-Council units will receive a link that can be bookmarked for future returns to continue the Summer Camp 2012 registration process

## **Step 2 - First Summer Camp Payment Due**

Using the "Registrations" link found on your Unit's Home Page (or bookmarked link for out-of council units), your 1<sup>st</sup> Summer Camp payment of \$250 (or remaining balance if you paid more than \$100 at the time of registration) is due on or before January 6, 2012. Choose "Make a Payment Against This Order." This payment will be applied toward your total camp fees and is non-refundable. Your timely attention to payment deadlines will help you avoid late fees!

## **Step 3 - Register Your Participants**

On February 1, 2012, participant registration will be enabled, allowing you to register your individual scout and adult campers. The \$135 minimum per Scout camper fee will be payable at the time of participant registration. Registering your youth & adults at this time will guarantee them a reservation for Summer Camp 2012. Summer Camp reservations are on a first-come, first-served basis; failure to register early may result in your week filling up and being closed to new reservations. You may pay online against the balance any time throughout the spring months with full payment being due on May 11, 2012. Payments made after May 11, 2012 will be charged the late fee with the exception of Webelos Crossovers & new Boy Scouts.

## **Step 4 - Sign Up for Merit Badges & Other Activities**

On March 1, 2012 the council will enable online signups for merit badge classes and other activities. You must have your participants registered first before they can sign up for classes and activities. Nearly all merit badge classes have an attendance limit, so registering your boys in a timely manner is advised to help make sure your boys get the merit badges they want.

### **Important Notes & Reminders**

- Except for Webelos Crossovers & new Boy Scouts, all Scout payments made after May 11<sup>th</sup> will be charged at the rate of \$295 per Scout. All Summer Camp payments are to be paid online or at the LHAC Service Center, P.O. Box 129, Auburn MI 48611-0129. Payments made outside of the LHAC website must be postmarked on or before the due dates; payments postmarked after the due dates are late and will be billed accordingly. Please make your check payable to "Lake Huron Area Council."
- If paying at the LHAC Service Center, troops are asked to please pay by a single troop check. Individual checks cause unnecessary delays and can create unit account problems.
- Each Unit or Provisional Scout must have their own camp account. Please do not combine different units, or youth from different units, under one account.
- The *Annual BSA Health & Medical Record* is due upon arrival at camp - do not send to the Service Center. All youth & adults must have the *Annual BSA Health & Medical Record* upon arrival at camp. The *Annual BSA Health & Medical Record* is valid for 1 year from the date signed by a physician for both youth & adults. No camper is allowed at camp without a valid *Annual BSA Health & Medical Record*!
- **CAMP ROTARY UNITS** - The LHAC *Release of Campers Form (not Part B/Adults Authorized To Take Youth To And From Events of the Health Form)* is also due upon arrival at camp and needs to be turned in to the Camp Office at the time of unit check-in. This form will be collected separately from the *Annual BSA Health & Medical Record*.
- Any outstanding unit balances must be paid upon arrival at camp. Camp reserves the right to limit attendance to Scouts & Adults declared on the May 11<sup>th</sup> unit roster. While every effort will be made to accommodate your campsite choice, LHAC reserves the right to make final campsite determinations which may result in 2 units sharing a site or a unit being moved based on paid registration numbers and campsite availability.
- Please review the LHAC Refund Policy prior to your arrival at camp. Camp fees can be transferred to new campers or adult leaders.
