

High Adventure SCUBA Experience at 2011 LDS Encampment at PBSR

All equipment is provided - mask, fins, snorkel, BCD, regulators, tanks, etc.!

Cost is only \$39/person. (This is in addition to the regular camp cost.)

Open to youth and adults!

- You will earn the SCUBA BSA Award patch.
- You will complete the first in-water lesson towards full SCUBA certification, which will be registered on-line with PADI.
- Great Turtle Diving & Sports will credit your cost towards a class if you choose to go on with certification through them within one year.



The training will include two parts:

- The first part will be classroom instruction at PBSR on Monday evening for everyone who is registered for SCUBA.
- The second part will be pool instruction and a SCUBA experience at the nearby Ogemaw Heights High School during one morning or afternoon period of the week. You will later be told the day and time for your pool session.
- The adults who participate will be asked to provide transportation to and from the High School.
- You must register on-line using links found at www.lhacbsa.org/LDS by **June 30, 2011**. (But sooner is better.) Payment must be made on-line using a credit card.
- Participants must qualify medically and complete all necessary paperwork. All forms are available at the on-line registration site.*
- All participants must pass the BSA swimmer test (blue swimmer) before their pool session. This can be done at scout camp.

*The Medical Statement form has questions which must be answered with a written "yes" or "no." A simple "Y" or "N" does not suffice. If any is answered yes, then the second page must be completed with a physician.
